SUBJECT: Idaho Driver License and ID Card Changes

Beginning in May 2011, and throughout the summer of 2011, the state of Idaho will:

- roll out new temporary and permanent driver license and new ID card designs with enhanced security features, produced on a more durable plastic than before; and
- change from an over-the-counter to a central issuance process.

These two changes will help prevent counterfeiting, reduce the risk of identity theft and fraud, and result in savings in driver license and ID card production costs for the state of Idaho, without raising the price of the documents for customers.

Current Idaho driver licenses and ID cards remain valid until it is time for the customer to renew.

Please see the attached two-page fact sheet for a summary of the enhanced security features, and for examples of how the new temporary driver license, permanent driver license, and ID card will look.
