SUBJECT: New Form for Electronic Ten-Day Time Extension for Motor Vehicle Inspection

Effective immediately, motorists can complete a vehicle registration online. At the completion of the online registration transaction, and after the motorist receives the license plates and registration sticker from DMV, the motorist can activate and print a new form VS-1077V "Electronic Ten-Day Time Extension for Motor Vehicle Inspection".

Form VS-1077V is intended to be displayed in the lower left corner of the windshield or kept with the vehicle registration document if the vehicle does not have a windshield. The expiration date of the 10-day time extension, license plate number, vehicle identification number and transaction number are printed on the face of the new form. Like the existing form VS-1077, form VS-1077V should only be displayed when a vehicle registration document and license plates are present.

The DMV will continue to issue form VS-1077 "Ten-Day Time Extension for Motor Vehicle Inspection" to motorists who register a vehicle in a DMV office, by mail, or using a DMV drop box.

Examples of form VS-1077V and form VS-1077 are attached for reference. The vehicle must be inspected before the expiration date that is printed on the front of the VS-1077V or within ten days of the date hand-stamped on the VS-1077.
