SUBJECT: New Inspection Certificates (Second Notice)

Beginning this month, December 2022, the Department of Motor Vehicles will begin to transition to print-on-demand inspection certificates. The transition will be accomplished gradually, in distinct phases, and is expected to be completed by the end of 2023.

We will notify you when the transition is complete. Until that time, a valid inspection certificate may be pre-printed OR print-on-demand.

Examples of all pre-printed and print-on-demand inspection certificates are shown in the following images:

The print-on-demand inspection certificate will enhance sticker security by adding vehicle-specific information directly onto the completed certificate.

## Notes:

- 1. All print-on-demand inspection certificates will have a ten (10) character "Cert#:" as shown in the examples above. However, our current electronic inspection record systems do not store the leading zeros found in some of the new inspection certificate numbers. The DMV is working to update these systems as the new inspection program is implemented.
- 2. The inspection certificate search function on law enforcement information systems is currently limited to eight (8) characters. Until the ten (10) character

update is made, law enforcement personnel can perform a search of "plate" or "VIN" to access the associated inspection certificate serial number information.
