SUBJECT: Revisions to the Police Accident Report

In January 2010, the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles began the process of revising the Police Accident Report. The purpose of this revision effort is to capture data elements mandated by the federal government or requested by our internal and external stakeholders, and to eliminate extraneous data elements that are no longer used. The new reports containing the majority of revisions are not expected to be printed until 2011 when the Accident Information System (AIS) will also receive a significant update to coincide with the release of the new police reports.

Due to upcoming federal mandates that require us to capture texting as a contributing factor in the new federal fiscal year (October 1st), we have implemented changes in AIS that will allow NYS DMV to begin capturing the new data as required. A total of seven (7) new human and vehicular contributing factor response codes have been added to the MV-104AC Police Accident Report Cover Sheet. A copy of the form has been attached and should be photocopied as needed. Unless otherwise indicated, the revisions described below will be identical on the MV-104A and MV-104AN once the forms are updated in 2011.

## Human:

29. Passing Too Closely

30. Vehicle Vandalism

- 31. Texting
- 32. Using On Board Navigation Device
- 33. Eating or Drinking

## Vehicular:

51. Tinted Windows

Officers completing an accident report using these values <u>must</u> provide an explanation in the "Accident Description/Officer's Note" section. The officer's notes are needed to provide an explanation of what the new response codes are to purchasers/recipients of these reports.
