SEC. 204. SUZANNE'S LAW.

Section 3701(a) of the Crime Control Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 5779(a)) is amended by striking ``age of 18" and inserting ``age of 21".

Note: This law amends the National Child Search Assistance Act of 1990.

TITLE XXXVII - NATIONAL CHILD SEARCH ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1990

SEC. 3701. REPORTING REQUIREMENT

- (a) In General - Each Federal, State, and local law enforcement agency shall report each case of a missing child under the age of 18 reported to such agency to the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) of the Department of Justice.
- (b) Guidelines - The Attorney General may establish guidelines for the collection of such reports including procedures for carrying out the purposes of this Act.
- (c) Annual Summary - The Attorney General shall publish an annual statistical summary of the reports received under this Act.
